

Greg went on to get a degree in civil engineering and left the United States to work in the bamboo flooring mills of Anji, China. During his fourteen-year career, Greg was tasked with researching biomaterials to make hardwood. He tested over 200 plant species using an algorithm he developed in college and discovered HempWood.

To date, the HempWood Headquarters resides in Murray, Kentucky where operations are focused on carbon negativity, sustainability, healthy materials. As the first USDA Certified BioPreferred Hardwood Flooring made in America, Fibonacci, LLC continues to pioneer the way for healthy, sustainable building materials.

OUR PROCESS

FARMING & GLUING

All of our hemp is sourced from within 100 miles of the HempWood® Headquarters in Murray, Kentucky. Local farmers grow this carbon-sequestering crop until maturity and then it is delivered to the facility. Upon arrival, the hemp is put through a roller to open the cell structure, which allows for the proteins of the plant-based adhesive to penetrate the material. After submerging the material in the ultra-low VOC, plant-based adhesive, the material is spread out on racks for the drying process, which takes place in custom-made drying containers.





PRESSING & BAKING

After drying and achieving a tacky-like texture, the dried material is portioned for pressing. The material is first placed into the pre-press, which allows for equal density and distribution in the HempWood® Blocks. After pre-pressing, the material is pushed through to the main press that utilizes 3,000 tons of pressure. The material is pressed into 5.5" x 5.5" x 6' steel mold and baked. After baking, the HempWood is extruded from the steel molds and cut.

HempWood® Natural Flooring, Lumber, Paneling, Woodturning Blanks, Cabinet Kits, and Picture Frames are all made from HempWood® Blocks. HempWood® Lumber is a non-structural hardwood intended for cabinetry, furniture, and other hobby wood applications. HempWood® Natural Flooring is an engineered flooring product that is comparable to American white oak. HempWood® products can be purchased factory direct or from a dealer in your area.

HempWood® Natural Flooring has a Janka Hardness Rating of 2,200 lbf, which is 20% harder than American white oak. The flooring is also CARB 2 and TSCA VI Compliant. In addition to the ultra-low VOCs, the fire rating is a Class 1, which is well above the commercial standard.

There are two categories of HempWood Organic Flooring - Premium Select and Common. Premium Select is intended for residential and commercial-grade applications. Common is intended for solely for residential applications.



FORMAT

Both Premium Select and Common Grade are constructed on an engineered format, meaning that plywood is used for the substrate and a HempWood is the top layer. Both categories, use the same materials, including adhesives, sealers, and finishes.



Hemp is a powerful plant. Estimates show that for every ton of hemp grown, 1.62 tons of carbon dioxide is removed. Additionally, our manufacturing process utilizes bio and hydro energy to make a carbon-negative building material.

INSTALLATION RECOMMENDATIONS

- Approved asbestos encapsulation method
- Warranted install over VCT Tile.
- Ensure VCT is secured subfloor.
- Ensure that the moisture levels are in accordance with HempWood Installation Instructions.
- For preparation, abrade the surfaces and clean up any debris.

 For installation, adhere the flooring to the subfloor as normal. Reference the HempWood Installation Instructions for adhesive recommendations. For commercial applications, square-edge, site-finished flooring is recommended.


